The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

SERVICE OPTIONS

NON-DECLINABLE BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service, available 24 hours a day; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; shelter of remains for the first 24 hours; crematory fee; and local transportation to the crematory. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations). . \$2,645

EMBALMING

DO NOT OFFER

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available

RECEIVING OF CREMATED REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME. DO NOT OFFER

Use of facilities and staff for a gathering and/or service when Williams Dingmann did not provide the initial services leading to the final disposition of the deceased. Our services include assistance with the obituary notices and staff necessary for the gathering and/or service. Our facility is available for use not to exceed four hours. See appropriate General Price List sections for additional services of our staff, use of the facility, (e.g. luncheon and times of funeral home usage), and automobile usage.

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME. DO NOT OFFER

This charge includes removal of remains, basic services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations and local transportation to MSP airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body. (Note: Shipping charges not included).

With minimum shipping container. DO NOT OFFER

Air tray. DO NOT OFFER

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME. DO NOT OFFER

This charge includes local transportation, transportation of remains to cemetery and basic services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL. DO NOT OFFER

The charge for immediate burial includes transfer of remains to funeral home, local transportation to the cemetery, necessary authorizations and basic services of staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, nor does it include an outer container or cemetery fees.

Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser. DO NOT OFFER

Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral home (in addition to the cost of the casket). DO NOT OFFER

DIRECT CREMATION.

The charge for direct cremation includes transfer of remains to funeral home, local transportation to the crematory, necessary authorizations and basic services of staff, and crematory fee. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation. Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are made of composition materials.
